Since I wrote to you in reply to your letter informing you that I did not wish to drag you all the way to Mandi, I have seen the two Farnans issued by His Exalted Highness, the second being dated the 17th of April 1941 in the press, and also I see in the press today the Gazette Extraordinary issued on the 7th of May by the Government of His Exalted Highness.

Without expressing my opinion with regard to these orders and declarations I am very anxious that you should not do anything until we meet in Bombay in the first week of June as I have already informed you to that effect. But if you still think that you cannot wait, then I shall be very glad to see you either at Mandi or Bangalore as I shall be returning to Bangalore on the 18th.
